Requirement	Action Required	Date Action Taken
Supervision - Stacker appointed?		
Is base level and can weight be sustained?		
Articles of same size shape and mass.		
Condition of pallets and/or containers.		
Articles are removed in a safe manner. (from top of stack)		
Stacks are stable and ladders or other safe facility is used to get onto stack.		
Stacks in danger of collapsing are safely and immediately dismantled.		
Stability of stacks not endangered by vehicles or other machinery or persons moving past them.		
Freestanding stacks of sacks, cases, cartons or similar containers are secured by laying up articles in a header and stretcher fashion and corners are securely bonded, and <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • stepped back half the depth of a single container at least every fifth tier, or • Successive tiers stepped back by a lesser unit provided the same angle of inclination to the vertical is achieved. 		
Containers of regular shape which ensures a stable stack-total height of stack not to exceed three times the smaller dimension of the underlying base of the stack. Approval of an inspector obtained to build to a height and in a manner permitted by the nature of the containers being stacked in excess of three times the smaller base dimension of stack.		
Stack heights displayed.		
Stacks stable and do not overhang.		
Operator of stacking machinery is rendered safe from falling articles.
